

Blockchain in Supply Chain Management

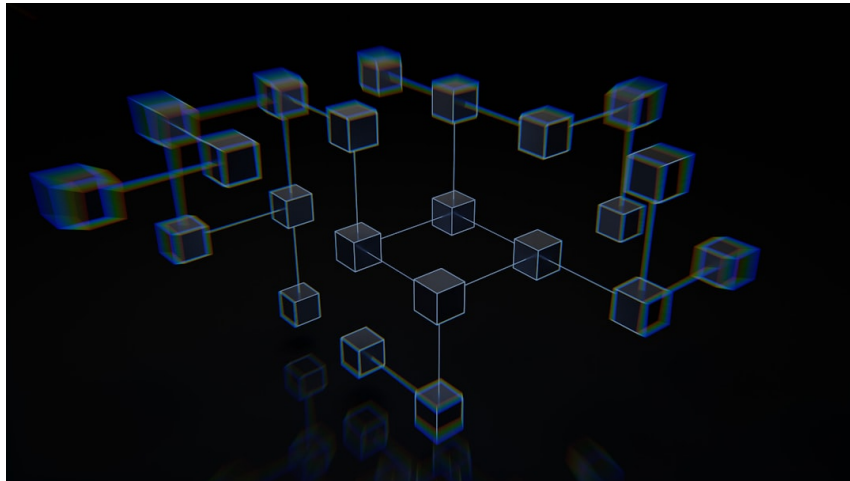

Supply chains involve dozens of parties — manufacturers, logistics providers, customs agencies, retailers — each maintaining separate records that rarely sync cleanly. Discrepancies between these siloed databases cause delayed shipments, disputed invoices, and costly reconciliation. Blockchain addresses this by giving every participant a shared, tamper-resistant ledger where each transaction is recorded once and visible to all authorized parties.

How the Technology Works in Practice

A blockchain is a distributed database where records are grouped into blocks, cryptographically linked to the previous block, and replicated across many nodes. No single party controls it. When a shipment leaves a factory, a transaction is recorded on-chain: timestamp, GPS coordinates, product identifiers, and the signing party's digital signature. Every subsequent handoff — warehouse receipt, customs clearance, last-mile delivery — adds another immutable entry. Any attempt to alter a past record breaks the cryptographic chain and is immediately detectable.

Smart contracts extend this further. These are self-executing programs stored on the blockchain that trigger actions when predefined conditions are met. A retailer can configure a smart contract to release payment automatically once an IoT sensor confirms a refrigerated shipment maintained the correct temperature throughout transit. This eliminates the manual invoice-approval cycle that often stretches to 30–90 days in traditional supply chains.

Real-World Deployments

Several large-scale pilots have moved beyond proof of concept. IBM Food Trust, built on Hyperledger Fabric, connects Walmart, Carrefour, Nestlé, and over 400 other food industry participants. When a contamination event occurs, participants can trace the origin of a specific product batch in seconds rather than the days or weeks required with paper-based systems. Walmart mandated the platform for all leafy green suppliers in 2019 after a series of E. coli outbreaks.

Maersk partnered with IBM to digitize global trade documentation through TradeLens, which at its peak processed data from more than 600 million shipping events annually. The platform reduced the volume of paperwork accompanying a single container shipment, which can run to 200 or more documents involving 30 different organizations. TradeLens was discontinued in 2022 due to difficulties achieving the industry-wide adoption needed to make the network commercially viable — a reminder that technology alone does not solve coordination problems.

Limitations and Open Questions

Blockchain does not verify the accuracy of data entered into it. If a supplier scans a counterfeit product as genuine, that false record becomes permanent. The technology guarantees that data has not been altered after entry; it cannot guarantee the data was correct to begin with. Integrating blockchain with IoT devices, RFID tags, and legacy ERP systems introduces significant technical and organizational complexity.

Interoperability between competing blockchain platforms remains unsolved. A shipment passing through multiple jurisdictions may touch several incompatible networks, recreating the fragmentation the technology was meant to eliminate.

Despite these challenges, the core value proposition holds where all participants agree on a shared platform and governance model. For high-value, regulated, or safety-critical goods — pharmaceuticals, fresh food, aerospace components — the audit trail blockchain provides is a meaningful operational improvement over the status quo.
