

EIP-1559 and Ethereum Fee Burning Explained

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Before August 2021, Ethereum users submitted gas bids in a blind auction. Miners selected whichever transactions offered the highest fees, creating volatile pricing and frequent overpayment. EIP-1559, activated in the London hard fork on August 5, 2021, replaced this system with a protocol-determined base fee and an optional priority tip paid directly to validators.

How the Base Fee Works

The base fee adjusts automatically based on block demand. When blocks are more than 50% full, the base fee rises by up to 12.5% per block. When blocks are less than 50% full, it falls by the same ceiling. This mechanism gives users a reliable estimate of the minimum fee required for inclusion in the next block, reducing the guesswork that previously made fee estimation unreliable. The priority tip, also called the miner tip or validator tip post-Merge, is a separate amount users can attach to incentivize faster inclusion.

The Burning Mechanism

The defining feature of EIP-1559 is that the base fee is not paid to validators — it is burned, meaning the ETH is permanently removed from circulating supply. Only the priority tip reaches the validator. Since deployment, this mechanism has destroyed well over 4 million ETH, though the precise running total changes with every block. During periods of high network activity, such as NFT mints or DeFi surges, the burn rate can exceed the rate at which new ETH is issued as validator rewards, making Ethereum net deflationary in those windows.

Impact on ETH Supply and Economics

Prior to the Merge in September 2022, Ethereum issued roughly 13,000 ETH per day to proof-of-work miners. After the Merge, issuance dropped to around 1,700 ETH per day for proof-of-stake validators. Combined with continuous base-fee burning, Ethereum's net annual issuance rate turned negative during high-activity periods, a property advocates call ultrasound money. This contrasts sharply with Bitcoin's fixed-schedule issuance and makes Ethereum's supply dynamics responsive to actual usage rather than a predetermined curve.

Limitations and Criticisms

EIP-1559 did not eliminate fee volatility. Base fees still spike sharply during congestion because the 12.5% per-block adjustment cap limits how quickly the protocol can respond to sudden demand. Users competing for block space during a popular token launch or network event can still pay very high fees. The change also shifted miner revenue toward MEV (maximal extractable value) strategies, as priority tips alone offered less predictable income than the old fee auction. Some critics argued that burning ETH benefits existing holders disproportionately while doing little to improve usability for ordinary users priced out during peak congestion. Scalability solutions such as rollups and EIP-4844 address the throughput side of the problem separately.
