

How Spot Bitcoin ETFs Changed the Cryptocurrency Market

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On January 11, 2024, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission approved eleven spot Bitcoin exchange-traded funds simultaneously, ending a decade-long regulatory standoff. The decision allowed products from BlackRock, Fidelity, Invesco, and others to begin trading on major stock exchanges the following day. Within the first week, these funds collectively attracted over \$10 billion in trading volume, signaling that pent-up institutional demand was real and immediate.

Institutional Capital Entered at Scale

Before spot ETFs existed, institutions wanting Bitcoin exposure faced significant friction. They could buy shares in Grayscale's Bitcoin Trust, which traded at persistent discounts or premiums to net asset value, or they could hold Bitcoin directly, requiring custody solutions most compliance departments rejected. Futures-based ETFs, approved in 2021, introduced tracking error and roll costs that eroded returns over time.

Spot ETFs eliminated these structural problems. BlackRock's iShares Bitcoin Trust, ticker IBIT, accumulated over 150,000 Bitcoin within its first two months of trading, making it one of the fastest-growing ETF launches in financial history. Pension funds, registered investment advisors, and family offices could now gain regulated, audited exposure through standard brokerage accounts. Morgan Stanley announced in August 2024 that its advisors could recommend spot Bitcoin ETFs to eligible clients, a policy shift that would have been unthinkable before SEC approval.

Price Discovery and Volatility Shifted

The presence of large, regulated funds with daily redemption mechanisms changed how Bitcoin's price forms. Authorized participants, typically large broker-dealers, arbitrage differences between the ETF share price and the underlying Bitcoin value, tightening spreads and connecting the crypto market more directly to traditional financial market hours and sentiment.

Coinbase, designated as custodian for several ETF products, saw its institutional custody business grow substantially. The exchange's role shifted toward being infrastructure for Wall Street rather than primarily a retail platform. This deepened liquidity at the spot level while also creating new correlations between Bitcoin and broader risk assets, since ETF holders respond to the same macro factors that move equities and bonds.

Supply Dynamics Were Altered

Spot ETFs function as a continuous buyer of Bitcoin on the open market when net inflows occur. Combined with the April 2024 halving, which cut the daily issuance of new Bitcoin from roughly 900 coins to 450, the structural supply pressure intensified. By mid-2024, ETF products were collectively absorbing multiples of the daily newly mined supply on strong inflow days.

This dynamic contributed to Bitcoin reaching a new all-time high above \$73,000 in March 2024, less than two months after ETF trading began. Critics noted that outflow periods could amplify downward moves equally, and that concentration of holdings among a few large custodians introduced new systemic considerations the market had not previously faced.

The approval of spot Bitcoin ETFs did not fundamentally change Bitcoin's underlying protocol, but it changed who owns it, how it is priced, and how it integrates with legacy financial systems in ways that will take years to fully measure.
